Applications are only approved by the ViNA Livability Committee once a month. <u>The monthly application deadline is the FIRST THURSDAY of the month</u>. The applications will be reviewed and an approval decision is made on the second Tuesday of the month.

Please include a copy of the following documents when submitting this application:

Required

- 1. A completed application form
- 2. Proof of ownership and occupancy
- 3. Before photos of space(s) where work is to be completed.

If applicable

- 4. For ALL projects involving work completed by a contractor:
 - a. Copies of at least two contractor bids for all work to be completed
 - b. Copies of selected contractor's State of MN or Minneapolis license (all contractors doing ANY job on your property require a license by the City if they're not already licensed by the state).
- 5. For any major renovation projects: architectural renderings
- 6. For ALL sweat equity projects: a materials list with associated costs

Incomplete applications with not be reviewed. Keep a copy of your signed application and all attachments for your records.
